

## Precision Dance Company Studio Policy - Recreation Classes 2025-2026



By signing below, I/We acknowledge that I/We have read, understand, and will abide by the expectations and payment policy of Precision Dance Company and have read and understand the releases stated herein.

I/We understand that the dance year of Precision Dance Company is organized on a 10-month schedule (two semester) schedule, August through May. The Company anticipates that each student will complete the dance year. The parents/guardians of a student who leaves prior to completion of the year will be responsible for notifying the studio, and at such time, responsible for that month's tuition and any items/costumes ordered for that student. All registration, tuition, costume, shoe, shirt, supply, and competition fees are non-refundable.

I/We understand the monthly fee of \$50 per child (PreK-4th Grade) and \$60 per child (5th-12th Grade) must be received by the 15th of each month, with April and May billed together and due April 15. For sibling groups of three or more dancers, the youngest dancer may receive discounted tuition. The failure to pay tuition on schedule will result in the addition of a late fee of \$10, and excessive nonpayments or late payments may result in the dismissal of the student from class. Costume deposits are split into two payments due in the fall, first due in September. Remaining costume balances, if any, will be billed in the spring. If a dancer's fees are 60 days past due, they may not return to class until outstanding balance is paid. Nonpayment of fees will prevent a dancer from participating in auditorium practices and the spring recital.

Precision Dance Company promotes kindness and teamwork to create an positive and respectful environment for dance. We will not tolerate bullying of any type. Any social media or public posts or comments perceived to be defamatory, threatening, harassing, discriminatory, or hateful towards the Company, students, or staff will not be tolerated. We expect dancers to behave properly during class and to be respectful of their teachers and peers. The Company reserves the right to cancel the enrollment of a child for reasons including, but not limited to, nonpayment or excessive late payment of fees, chronic behavioral disruption or bullying, and violation of studio policies by dancer or parent/guardian.

We understand that photos and videos of our child may be used in newspapers and other media as our child participates in activities concerning Precision Dance Company that are deemed of public interest, and Precision Dance Company may publish our child's picture in the newspaper, dance program book, and studio social media as advertising or basic studio publicity.

While our child/children are participating in this activity, we agree to allow director or representative of Precision Dance Company to sign any medical forms necessary for any urgent medical treatment which may be required, should our child be injured. THIS IS ONLY IF PARENTS, GUARDIANS, OR EMERGENCY CONTACT CANNOT BE CONTACTED. It is IMPERATIVE that you list your emergency contacts on the registration forms. This agreement and release is signed this day and is binding upon the signees, their heirs, executors, and assigns.
